This directory brings together information about community transport groups and services in Oxfordshire. The directory was initially compiled using information brought together from two websites: <u>www.communitynetworkdirectory.org.uk/search</u> and <u>www.livewell.oxfordshire.gov.uk</u>.

The directory is updated periodically by direct discussion with providers to check that their contact and other information remains accurate, along with local research to ensure that information for as many schemes and operators as possible is contained within.

What is community transport?

Community transport is run by the community for the community, meeting needs that are not catered for in other ways. Some groups offer services just for their members, others are open to the public. The type of service offered can vary from timetabled bus services to car schemes taking village residents to their local surgery, shops or other services.

The directory provides contact information, a description of the area of coverage and an outline of the service provided for each entry. Some community transport schemes serve mainly older people, others those in their local communities, while others again offer mainly transport to health care.
